How to Measure Your Room

- Draw a rough floor plan of the room. Don't worry about scale; just draw the room's basic shape.
- Measure the room from wall to wall in each direction, to get an overall length and width for the room.
- On your floor plan, indicate where any doors, windows, built-in cabinetry or fireplaces are located. Again, do not worry about scale.
- Take more detailed measurements of each wall. For example, if you have a wall with a fireplace on it, measure from one end of the wall to where the fireplace begins. Then measure the width of the fireplace. Then measure from the end of the fireplace to the end of the wall. These three distances should add up to the overall measurement you took initially. Repeat this process with each wall.
- Measure the height of the ceiling.
- Measure from the floor to the windowsill of any windows in the room.
- Measure the heights of all windows and doors.
